SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT*

The spirit of the Catholic School League is to encourage participation, strengthen self-esteem and have fun while playing the sport of interest. All coaches in the CSL must adhere to a Coaches Code of Ethics and we expect our parents and fans to set a positive example for our children to follow as well.

- RESPECT authority and teach the players to respect authority by your example
- Do not make personal remarks to officials. Those who do will be warned to stop and asked to leave the facility if they do again.
- Always treat the facility you are in with RESPECT.
- Be a POSITIVE EXAMPLE for all our athletes. They look to adults for guidance, don't let them down.
- ***BE A GREAT AMBASSADOR FOR YOUR SCHOOL.*** Others will judge your school by your actions.
- Instruct and reinforce your athletes to be Gracious Winners, and accept defeat in stride
- Never, ever, yell at, 'boo' or 'heckle' an opposing player, team, coach, or referee
- Your teams' reputation is built not only on playing ability but also on sportsmanship, courtesy and manners.
- This is elementary school athletics. There are no scouts or recruiters in the stands. Our student athletes are learning to play the game. There are many life lessons to be learned, from winning and losing. Support all those who come out to play.
- ***All spectators and fans are expected to conduct themselves with the highest level of sportsmanship at all times. Any on-site Athletic Director or referee has the authority to remove any person from our facilities who does not comply with our Spectator Code of Conduct. Any person removed from any game risks being sanctioned by the NB CSL board of directors and banned from attending future games.***
